The talented Jewish scientist (convinced in Protestantism) was one of the first women in Germany to be awarded a doctorate in chemistry at the end of the 1900s. However, during her marriage, she was refused an academic career as a being a woman, she was refused an academic career as a woman. Fritz Haber (1868-1934)
Notwithstanding the eminent chemist is considered as one of the most controversial figures of the 20th century. He was the father of the German "poison gas war", however, as the discoverer of the extraction process of nitrogen for the production of artificial fertilizers, he made a decisive contribution to the feeding of the growing world population. During the First World War he was in Germany as a chemist in 1918. During the First World War he, as a Jew (converted to Protestantism), committed himself to the principle "No price for mankind's welfare", but became a victim of the growing anti-Semitism and had to emigrate in 1933. The Nobel Prize in Chemistry was awarded to him in 1918.

Fritz Hober (1868-1934)

Der bedeutende Chemiker gilt heute als einer der unruhigsten Persönlichkeiten des 20. Jahrhunderts. Er war der Vater des deutschen „Gültigkeitkrieges“, hat aber die Entdeckung des deutschen Gewinnens von Stickstoff zur Herstellung von Kunstdünger maßgeblich dazu beigetragen, das wachsende Weltbevölkerung ernähren zu können. Dafür erhielt er 1912 den Nobelpreis für Chemie zugesprochen. Als junger Mann wurde er in den ersten Weltkrieg hineingezogen und wurde im August 1914 in Frankreich bei Verdun getötet.
