

# THE NET-IDEA PROJECT



## General Overview

The Project NET-IDEA aims at reinforcing the role of local authorities and their cooperation in the field of diversity promotion, interculturalism, anti-discrimination and inclusion of minorities.

It is funded by the European Commission within the CERV-2021-CITIZENS-TOWN Call for Proposal and will last **24 MONTHS** from May 2022 to April 2024.

NET-IDEA counts on the support of the Intercultural Cities Programme (ICC Programme) of the Council of Europe.



# Specific Objectives

- →Strengthen the **competences** of European Cities in the implementation of effective policies to promote Equality, Diversity and Inclusion of Minorities.
- →Promote a **long-term cooperation** between European Cities and the exchange of best practices on Anti-Discrimination, Diversity and Inclusion of Minorities.
- →Increase among citizens, and youth in particular, participation and rights-awareness on intercultural societies in European Cities.

- → Peer-to-Peer Cooperation
- →Multi-Stakeholder Cooperation with CSOs & Youth Groups
- →Testing of Direct Actions with the Cities


